

Lenten Food Collection

Throughout Lent, St. Mark's centered our hearts and focused our faith by collecting items for the St. Andrew's Food Bank. Although we continually collect items for the food bank, during the six weeks of Lent we collected the following items:

- 86 rolls of TP
- 42 rolls of paper towels and napkins
- 72 cleaning products such as wipes, dishwashing liquid, sponges, household cleaners, and laundry detergent
- 28 boxes of tissues
- 12 boxes of plastic bags
- 145 individual personal care products such as mouthwash, shampoos, toothpaste, toothbrushes, deodorant, and bar soap
- 71 boxes of cereal/granola bars
- 44 canned goods
- 21 miscellaneous food items and infant needs (packages of baby wipes, diapers, and baby foods)

The Food Bank is open twice a month (the 1st and 3rd Wednesdays) and the donations were delivered on March 18 and April 1, 2026. On March 18, 52 families were provided with food and household and personal care products items. The next date that St. Mark's is scheduled to work at the Food Bank is Wednesday, May 20, 2026. Thank you to all for providing these much-needed paper products, cleaning supplies, personal care products and food.
