Dear People of St. Mark's,

They said how much they love being at worship, how much they appreciate the people of St. Mark's, and how meaningful it is to be part of a community where everyone is known by name. Hearing that helped me realize how much I, too, look forward to Sunday mornings and how good it makes me feel to belong to a peaceful, loving congregation. St. Mark's is truly a place where I have found a home and where the living presence of the Holy Spirit is at work.


