Thoughts from the Pastor:

Dear Members of St. Mark's,

Lent is one of the church's most important seasons not because it is busy, but because it is honest. Lent invites us to slow down, to think, to listen, and to return to the Lord with open hearts. It is a season for renewal.

In planning for Lent this year, we have been thinking carefully about when our people truly have the ability to gather. Attendance for weekly midweek Lenten services has been harder to sustain, but support for the central "big" services has remained strong especially **Ash Wednesday, Maundy Thursday, and Good Friday**. When those services arrive, people make a point of being there. They matter to us, and it shows.

So this year we are taking a focused approach: we will keep our strongest anchors exactly as we have done, and we will add a small, low-risk noon-time experiment that removes the night-driving barrier and helps us learn what works best for our congregation.

The "Big" Midweek Services

- **Ash Wednesday February 18 at 6:00 PM, Maundy Thursday April 2 at 6:00 PM, Good Friday April 3 at 6:00 PM**

• Sunset April 2 and 3 is about **7:30 PM**, so a 6:00 PM service keeps us in the evening while making travel easier.

These services are the heart of Lent and Holy Week. We are not reducing our commitment to them. We are leaning into them.

New: Two Special Wednesday Noon Gatherings

(with lunch, a hymn, and a presentation) **Wednesday, March 4 Noon (12:00 PM) Wednesday, March 18 Noon (12:00 PM)**

Each of these will be a simple and welcoming mid-day gathering, including **lunch, a hymn, and a presentation by Pastor Kleist**. These noon services allow us to offer something meaningful in daylight hours without asking people to commit to six weeks of additional evening driving.

This is a low-risk, learn-as-we-go experiment. If these two noon lunches are well attended and encouraging, we can consider doing more next year. If not, we will have learned something about what works best for St. Mark's.

Lent is not about proving anything. It is about returning: returning to contemplation, returning to God's mercy, and returning to what matters most.

I hope you will join us for Ash Wednesday, Maundy Thursday, and Good Friday. And I hope you will consider trying one of the noon lunch services during Lent. Come for the food, sing a hymn, listen and reflect, and enjoy fellowship in the middle of the day.

Let's walk this season together with steadiness and hope.
