
ST. MARK'S DECEMBER 2025 NEWSLETTER

December is upon us, and it is truly the busiest and most joyful month of the year at St. Mark's! As we prepare our hearts for the coming of Christ, there is much to celebrate, reflect on, and do together.

Our December joy is this year tempered by the death of our brother Lee Koehler. His memorial service will be December 13th in our sanctuary. We will be hosting a reception immediately following the worship service.

We will kick off the season by decorating the church for Christmas on The First Sunday of Advent: November 30. Come and join in the festive fun as we adorn our sanctuary with the beauty of the season. Your help is greatly appreciated in making our worship space ready to celebrate the birth of Christ.

Each week of Advent my sermons will focus on a different theme, using the following passages:

- Advent 2: Matthew 3:1-12: The Ministry of John the Baptist. John's call to "prepare the way of the Lord" invites us to reflect on how we are making room for Christ in our lives.
- Advent 3: Matthew 11:2-11: John the Baptist asks: "Are you the one who is to come." We see Jesus as the fulfilment of every expectation.
- Advent 4: Matthew 1:18-25: We hear about the faithfulness of Jesus' earthly father Joseph, who supported Mary and protected Jesus.

I hope this series will inspire you to embrace the spirit of Advent and prepare your heart for the celebration of Christmas.

Advent is a season of anticipation, repentance, preparation, and joy as we remember the coming of Christ. Let's journey together in faith, hope, and love!




